Club Championships

Policy and Procedures Manual - 404

The Pioneer Archers are committed to recognising the achievements of our athletes by establishing Championship rules that reflects an athlete's commitment and consistency throughout the shooting year .

Club Championships Policy

- 1) Only financial members of the club can participate in the Club Championship Rankings, the days that the rounds are to be shot are identified on the club calendar by the letters (CCE) after the round name. The Club Championship Events (CCE) will form the basis of determining the club champions in any given year.
- 2) The three best FITA 1440 rounds, the two best FITA 900 rounds and the three best FITA/AA 720 rounds shot by the individual archer during the course of the calendar year will be used to determine the archer's overall club ranking. The individual score for each round will totalled and the archers will then be ranked from the highest total to the lowest total in each of the Bow disciplines.
- 3) There will be a Male and Female Junior and Male and Female Senior Club Champion in each of the recognised disciplines for each calendar year.
- 4) The FITA 1440 round and FITA/AA 720 round that the individual archer is required to shoot will be the same as those rounds nominated in AA QRE policy document 1031 (see Schedule A) except for the Veteran Plus Category. An Archer can choose to shoot only the two (2) longest distances on their respective FITA 1440 round, the score will be ranked as a 720 round. The intension to shoot the longer distance only must be indicated to the Director of Shooting (DoS) before the archer commences shooting on the day.
- 5) The FITA 900 (Canberra) rounds that can be shot by an archer for the purpose of ranking will be as per Schedule B.
- 6) If an archer shoots a round which is of less distance than their respective designated round, the score will not be used in the calculation for the archer's club ranking.
- 7) The archer must shoot at least one of the ranking rounds during the calendar year to be eligible for ranking.
