EQUIPMENT OFFICER

- There are currently seven (7) Target buttresses in service and a further two (2) sitting on top of the toolbox waiting for frames to be made
- The club would like to thank Parish Bhana for putting the backstop together. The back stop is currently under trial and thus far working very well; it will provide the club a far more economic solution to the need for backstops on the targets
- The club still holds a few spare target cores, and all targets are still hold up well under use

- There will soon be a need to purchase more target faces. The club will purchase the Bjorn faces; while these are a little more expensive at point of purchase, their longevity makes them overall a more cost effective choice

JUDGE CANDIDATE/CLUB INSTRUCTOR

- Trevor Greenham has now attended the most recent Judge's Course run by Archery Western Australia (AWA), and has now qualified as a National Judge Candidate
- This now makes it a very easy task for the Club to register and hold Qualifying Ranking Events (QREs) at the Club grounds, and will help assist members who are working towards the higher classifications such as Master Bowman (MB) and Grand Master Bowman (GMB)
- A QRE cost \$10.00 to register, and must be registered at least 30 days prior to the event; a tournament cost between \$40.00 and \$60.00 to register, depending on whether it is a National or World Archery tournament, and must be registered at least 60 prior to the event
- The question was put to the club regarding how the cost of registering a QRE should be apportioned – as either a levy on the target fees for those entering, or should the club absorb the cost. After some discussion the Club determined that to absorb the cost of registering QREs was at this stage no great impost, so it will be done that way
- Once the full process of qualification has been completed, Trevor will also be able to officiate at Tournaments, and the Club can then look at also registering tournaments some time later in 2016
- This will offer to members further opportunity to qualify for the higher classifications of MB and GMB, as well as the Elite levels of Bronze, Silver and Gold. Tournaments will also afford the opportunity for achieving FITA Stars, Australian Stars, and vying for National Records
